"Tirana Ime 2.0 – PharmaWipe"	Resource Environmental Center (REC) in Albania (Tirana)	Tirana, Albania	<p>Introduction of a new functionality in the existing app "Tirana Ime 2.0" developed by the Municipality of Tirana. The new functionality will be dedicated to the selective collection of pharmaceutical waste (PhW). The existing interface known to some 130,000 users will be maintained.</p> <p>In connection with the new functionality, a pilot system with three PhW collection points in pharmacies will be established. A community event and promotional actions will also be organized. 4 types of users (and target groups)</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Individual users (citizens) - shall be able to identify the nearest pharmacy that accepts PhW 2. Pharmacy shops - who shall be able to document the amount of PhW stored by them 3. Certified collectors - who shall know when to collect accumulated PhW at the pharmacies that do store it 4. Municipality of Tirana - who will know how much PhW was properly collected, and not end up in its landfills, and benefit from having well-informed consumers and pharmaceutical operators.
